MESSAGE

I am delighted to learn that General Economics Division (GED) is going to publish the '2nd National Action Plan of Ministries/Divisions by Targets for the Implementation of SDGs' aligning the 8th Five-Year Plan with the SDGs. This document will serve as a key instrument in taking the initiatives of the SDGs' implementation further forward in Bangladesh.

In 2018, by aligning the 7th Five-Year Plan with the SDGs under the umbrella of 'National Action Plan of Ministries/Divisions by Targets for the Implementation of SDGs, the Government assigned specific duties to 43 Ministries/Divisions depending on the allocation of business, designating them as lead, co-lead, or associate implementors of the SDGs' targets. The 2nd SDG Action Plan will expedite the SDG-based progress in a more organized way to achieve the targets by 2030.

SDG is a comprehensive matter and thus calls for a holistic approach. The government is not only undertaking a whole of society approach to SDG implementation but also is encouraging action by NGOs, CSO, Development Partners, and Private Sector. The motto of "leave no one behind and reach the farthest behind first" is the leading milestone of all our development interventions. According to the HIES Report 2022, the upper poverty line is decreased from 24.3% (2016) to 18.7 % at the national level. The lower poverty line is 5.6 % at the national level while it was 12.9 % in 2016. The average monthly per capita income reported at the national level in HIES 2022 is Tk. 7,614 while in 2016 average national income per capita was Tk. 3,940. In 2016, the rate of access to electricity (National Grid/Solar electricity) in Bangladesh was 75.92%, now the rate is 99.34%. All such positive signals show that under the strong leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, Bangladesh is on the right track to achieve SDGs on time. The dream of Bangabandhu of making our country Sonar Bangla will come true as well.

Genuinely speaking, we have to walk a long way. Similar to other nations, Bangladesh has faced some significant obstacles that have hampered its ability to advance toward its sustainable development goals. These obstacles include the Covid-19 crisis' effects, the fallout from the Russia-Ukraine crisis, and climate change. Therefore, in the seven years left, we should work together to achieve inclusive, human-centered, and holistic development.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the GED officials for their initiative and hard work and the different ministries/divisions for providing their valuable input in the preparation of this important document.

A PREFATORY NOTE

The '2nd National Action Plan of Ministries/Divisions by Targets for the Implementation of SDGs' is a comprehensive strategy that encompasses the actions of various Ministers/Divisions identified in the SDGs Mapping Handbook. This Action Plan is designed to effectively implement the goals and associated targets outlined in the SDGs, spanning three consecutive Five Year Plans (7th, 8th, and 9th FYP) in alignment with the Development Budgetary provisions of the Government of Bangladesh.

A robust follow-up and review mechanism are indispensable for the successful implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. A well-structured plan of action is essential to continuously monitor progress, providing valuable insights to policymakers for evidence-based decision-making. This approach guarantees transparency and accountability at every stage of implementation, ensuring the effective realization of this ambitious development agenda. Moreover, coherence between the SDG framework and the national development plan, i.e., Annual Development Program (ADP) is crucial for the integration of this global agenda with the development plan and priorities of the government.

GED already revised the mapping document of the SDG with a particular focus on the duties and responsibilities of ministries/divisions as lead, co-lead, or associate in achieving the SDG targets, assigning respective govt. entities for data generation, or identifying the custodian roles of development partners in facilitating the SDG implementation. In addition, GED has taken a candid and in-depth overview regarding the implementation and progress of the 1st National Action Plan, by identifying the achievements, challenges, and future course of action. In between, the 8th Five Year Plan (8FYP) also became operationalized. Therefore, the formulation of the 2nd National Action Plan of SDGs became the paramount need to incorporate and align the targets and strategies of the 8FYP with the SDGs. A preliminary in-house analysis was done at GED on the format for ensuring to capture the plan of action of Ministries/Divisions for all the 169 SDG targets for the 8th Five-Year Plan period and beyond. The format was sent to Ministries/Divisions for their feedback/input. Subsequently, during the period of January to February 2023, the GED (General Economics Division) facilitated four consultation workshops involving lead ministries/divisions. These workshops also included representatives from the office of the Principal Coordinator (SDG Affairs) at the Prime Minister's Office, as well as the Governance Innovation Unit (GIU) at the Prime Minister's Office. Building upon the fruitful discussions held during these workshops, the lead ministries/divisions diligently formulated and submitted their respective action plans.

Though an intense consultation process was followed in preparing this document, this action plan may require revision in the future if required as it has been prepared in alignment with the 8FYP, and currently, a mid-term review of the 8FYP is ongoing. In this sense, we may consider this action plan a dynamic/living document. In the endeavor of formulating the 2nd SDGs Action Plan, which holds the promise of contributing to the fulfillment of both national and the 2030 Agenda objectives, my profound gratitude goes out to the concerned officials of GED, the Principal Coordinator (SDG Affairs) Office, GIU, and the esteemed ministries/divisions for their unwavering and unwavering cooperation throughout the preparation process.

THE PROCESS AND THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Over the course of two years, an extensive process comprising a series of reviews and consultation workshops was undertaken to raise awareness among Ministries/Divisions/Agencies about the vastness, significance, and intricacy of the Sustainable Development Goals, as well as to design the 2nd National Action Plan. Following the approval of the 8th Five Year Plan (8FYP), the General Economics Division (GED) initiated an evaluation of the 1st National Action Plan of SDGs to assess progress made by Ministries/Divisions, analyze existing gaps, identify challenges, and offer recommendations for the 2nd SDG Action Plan. This inclusive and participatory report serves as an informative repository, highlighting successful practices, lessons learned, and challenges in SDGs implementation, while also establishing a foundation for global-level accountability. Concurrently, GED undertook the formulation of the 2nd Action Plan by integrating 8FYP targets into the SDGs through brief consultations with lead ministries/divisions, leading to the organization of several consultation workshops between 2021 and 2022 for the preparation of the 2nd Action Plan.

In this whole process, the engagement of stakeholders has been ensured to comply with the principle of SDGs which is “leave no one behind”. In this way, the Ministries/Divisions realized the importance and gravity of the agenda and grew their ownership consciously or subconsciously to implement it effectively. Though the re-emergence of the COVID-19 Pandemic has imposed some restrictions on organizing in-person consultations, GED maintained its communication with respective ministries/ divisions and other stakeholders. In early December 2022, GED initiated the updating of this action plan. In this process, 04 series of consultation workshops were held on 19 January 2023, 26 January 2023, 31 January 2023, and 07 February 2023 with lead ministries/divisions in the presence of representatives from the Principal Coordinator (SDGs Affairs) office, Prime Minister’s Office and Governance Innovation Unit (GIU), Prime Minister’s Office. Those consultations were extensively rigorous with the active participation of the ministries/divisions. After the workshops, all ministries/ divisions were requested to correct/modify their action plan which they did and resubmitted again accordingly. In between, concerned officials from GED were actively in touch with the focal persons from ministries/divisions.

The format of the Action Plan was primarily developed by GED. Three former officials Mr. Md. Mahbulul Haque Patwary, former Joint Chief, GED (now Additional Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture), Mr. Md. Mahbulul Alam Siddiquee, former Deputy Chief, GED (now Deputy Secretary, Statistics, and Informatics Division), and Mr. Md Zariab Hossain, former Senior Assistant Chief, GED (now on deputation for higher study) made a contribution in this regard. Throughout the entire process, a dedicated core team, led by the prudent and dynamic Dr. Md. Kawser Ahmed, Member (Secretary) of General Economics Division (GED), played a pivotal role in the development of this document. The team, consisting of Dr. Munira Begum, Joint Chief, Ms. Rumana Rahman Shampa, Deputy Chief, Mr. Mohammad Fahim Afsan Chowdhury, Senior Assistant Chief, and Mr. Shimul Sen, Senior Assistant Chief, worked cohesively from the inception to the publication of the final draft. A special acknowledgment is owed to Khan Md. Nurul Amin, ndc, Chief (Additional Secretary) of GED, for his extensive contributions and invaluable guidance.

Our sincere appreciation is extended to all SDG Focal Point Officers and concerned officials from Ministries/Divisions for their valuable contributions.
